



Monthly and Weekly Extended Stay Agreement

1. You certify that you have a primary residence other than use of this room and the address provided at the time of check-in is that address.
2. Guest rooms may not be shared with anyone other than those listed with the hotel register. "Hot rooming," or sharing the room with another guest or guests continuously over a 24-hour cycle, is prohibited.
3. You may not sublet your room.
4. If you end your stay early during your monthly or weekly stay, there are no refunds. We have blocked this room out for the term of your stay, preventing reservations during that time.
5. Non-emergency office hours are 7:00 AM through 10:30 PM.
6. Quiet hours are 9:00 PM through 11:00 AM.
7. Partying with your co-workers outside your rooms may disturb other guests. The front courtyard and grassy area behind our main building, as well as Littlefield's three neighborhood parks, are perfect for gatherings. Complaints of noise or harassment from guests are considered serious and may result in your removal from the property, without refund.
8. Linens and towels are for in-room service and are not rags. Please do not remove them from the room. You will be billed for linens and towels which are missing, or are soiled or otherwise damaged beyond normal use.
9. Clean up after yourself. Repeated incidents of littering motel grounds with cigarette butts, drink containers, food, bottle caps or other trash will lead to an involuntary early departure, without refund.
10. Outgoing mail may be left at the front desk during non-emergency office hours for pick-up for USPS. We will not hold packages for pick-up by any carrier. Any inbound mail sent to you and received during your stay may be picked up at the office during normal hours (see Item 5). Any mail or packages received after your departure will be returned to sender. We will not forward mail or packages and there are no exceptions to this policy.
11. For monthly stays, we will do a walk-through of your room the day before departure.
12. In-room use of crock pots, hot plates, griddles or any other gas, electric, or open-fired cooking or heating appliance not provided by Crescent Park Motel is prohibited by Littlefield and Texas fire codes. If you have a personal grill, you must cook at least 25 feet from the building and in a manner such that smoke does not drift into guest rooms. Grills must be attended to at all times and off-site disposal of used charcoal is the guest's responsibility. Storage of charcoal or charcoal starting fluid is the guest's responsibility and may not be stored in your room or adjacent to the motel. Occasionally, Lamb County and the City of Littlefield are subject to open air burning restrictions which may impact outdoor cooking.
13. No vehicle maintenance may be performed on motel property. The only exceptions are emergency services such as jump starting, towing off the property, lockout service or changing a tire.
14. The city pool area is off limits to motel guests. You will be evicted if you enter this area and may be subject to trespassing prosecution.
15. Extensions of your stay may be made monthly, weekly or daily at our current rates based on room availability.
16. This Agreement is in addition to those stated on your rental receipt or posted in your room.
17. This Agreement applies to any contiguous extension of your stay.

Violations of this Agreement may result in eviction from the property without refund and may subject you to additional damage billings.
